Current Situation

We will be under Red Flag Warnings until Saturday morning. The upper elevations will remain in the 70-80's with winds possibly gusting up to 30mph in the evenings. During the day, the winds will continue, and the temperatures could reach the triple digits. Crews continue to take aggressive action towards securing any residual heat signatures and visible smokes in all areas of the fire. We continue to use the UAS IR (Drone) and VETS to assist the firefighters in their efforts locating the heat signatures. Helicopters will be used to extinguish fire in the areas that are to steep for the crews to get into.

Forest Order 05-07-51-20-20 Dolan Fire Emergency Area Closure is currently in place. Nacimiento-Ferguson RD is closed to all traffic (public and residential) from Highway 1 to the Fort Hunter Liggett base boundary line (16 mile inland). This closure includes the intersection with the South Coast Ridge Road at Nacimiento- Ferguson Road Summit, Arroyo Seco RD at Elm AVE, Carmel Valley RD at Mile Post 29, at 39201 Cahoon Grade, Elm Ave. ¼ mile south of Arroyo Seco, Reliz Canyon RD at Elm Ave.

Evacuations: - The Evacuation WARNINGS have been lifted for Zones: 26, 24, B2- Lucia South, J-Prewitt Ridge Area, K-South Coast Ridge Rd. Zone 27 has been downgraded to WARNING. For current evacuation information view the OES interactive map or call 211.

Closures: The Los Padres National Forest extended the forest recreation closure through October 1, 2020. Nacimiento-Ferguson Road is closed to all traffic from Highway 1 to the Fort Hunter Liggett base boundary line. For more information visit <https://roads.dot.ca.gov/>
