Come fly like a California Condor and see what animals thrive at Pfeiffer Big Sur State Park in various habitats. Trail and park information available. Located on the Warden's Path.



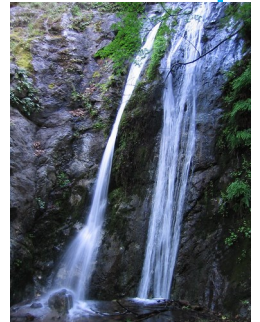
Saturday, November 18th

11:00 a.m. Children's Nature Walk "Birds, Bugs, and Banana Slugs"



Look at life in the forest from a bug's point of view and discover how some of the smallest forest creatures have the biggest impact. This easy walk and fun activities will last about an hour. All ages welcome. Meet Naomi at the Campfire Center.

2:00 p.m. "Nature Walk: Gear Shifts and Waterfalls" Although best known for its beauty and scale, Big Sur offers a great diversity of plants, animals, and climates. We will explore how and why Big Sur's landscape can change rapidly in a matter of minutes. Meet Naomi at the Redwood Deck for this moderate 2-mile hike to Pfeiffer Falls."

Saturday, November 25th

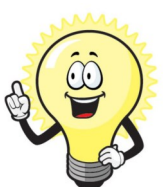
